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# The draft of the development principles according to the Building Act in relation to the Mining Act

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## State Mining Administration

- a relevant authority in land-use planning activities
  - one of competences concerns principles of territorial development.
- > Czech Mining Authority makes standpoints to
  - politics of territorial development,
  - principles of territorial development from the view of protection and utilization of mineral resources - Mining Act.
  - Assessment
    - acceptance of suggestion, acceptance of suggestion with conditions or nonacceptance of suggestion.

#### **SURIS**

- Part of the Geological Information System (GeolS) operated by Czech Geological Survey.
- SURIS Information system of raw materials
  - > important source of information for opinion,
  - > includes a lot of spatial information
    - > still active mining claims,
    - mining claims with terminated activities.

Each object: own identification number;

possibility to find basic information about mining claims e.g. operator, mining, minerals.

# Mining areas in past

- Mining areas with terminated activities
  - became places with illegally disposed waste,
  - > a part of brownfields.
- REASONS to take into account when
  - planning development of entire administrative territories,
  - > use of land after remediation and reclamation,
  - placement of new projects
  - possible changes in land use.

# Drawing up draft of development principles

- Draft of development principles is procured
  - by regional office upon assignment or report on development principles implementation according Building Act,
    - > **publicly discussed** and agreed with all relevant authorities.
- Regional office shall ensure assessment of impacts on area sustainable development to draft of development principles.

#### Joint debate

#### Regional office

- notifies of place and time of joint debate on draft of development principles,
- calls upon relevant authorities to submit assessments within time limit laid down by law.

There are not taken into account assessments and remarks of administrative regions, which are submitted later. This "concentration principle" is applied at all stages of acquisition of principles of territorial development.

## The public hearing

- of modified and assessed draft principles of territorial development after a joint debate, including assessment of impacts on area sustainable development
  - ➤ is announced by regional office by a public notice;
- Czech Mining Authority
  - right sets an assessment on parts of solution that have been changed since joint debate.

# Regional office (1)

- Evaluates results of debate
- Prepares
  - >draft of decision on objections,
  - >draft evaluation of comments with regard to public interests.
- Proposals forward to authorities concerned and invite to submit assessment within stipulated period.

# Regional office (2)

- Relevant authority does not apply assessment within stipulated period
  - it is applied that **relevant authority agrees** with submitted draft.
- If necessary
  - > regional office shall ensure
    - modification of draft of development principles
      - ➤ in accordance with results of public debate.

## Development principles

- Can be updated using
  - >above-mentioned procedure
  - ➤or shortened procedure according to Building Act.

- In practice
- shortened procedure is not often used for development principles.

# Spatial and regulatory plans

- At regional level
- > spatial plans and regulatory plans.
- Aacquisition or acquisition of changes
- > spatial analysis documents are used
  - > part of spatial planning documents.

Municipalities with extended powers (ORP) and regions must obtain territorial analytical documents - content is determined by legal regulation.

# Databases of territorial analytical data

- Databases of territorial analytical data by remote access through ORP
- including a survey of sustainable development of territory,
- analysis of sustainable development of territory according to Building Act,
- source of data for so-called phenomenon No 64 "old burdens and contaminated areas".

Phenomenon No. 64 and utilization for planning documentation of ORP was used as a source of information for the national inventory of contaminated sites of CR.

#### Conclusion

- SURIS part of Geological Information System (GeoIS)
  - source of information for national inventory of contaminated sites of Czech Republic,
  - >could be used like phenomenon
  - No. 64 "old burdens and contaminated areas"
